Limpopo Government hosts Lekgotla and Premier's Employment Growth Advisory Council

The Limpopo Provincial Government will hosts the EXCO Lekgotla and Premier's Employment Growth Advisory Council on the 14 and 15 November at Zebula Golf Estate, Bela-Bela Municipality, Waterberg respectively.

EXCO Budget Lekgotla

Premier of Limpopo, Mr Chupu Stanley Mathabatha will on the 14 November 2018 deliver the opening address at the EXCO Budget Lekgotla. The Lekgotla is a high level strategic meeting that discuss issues of service delivery impact. It's attended by all Members of the Executive Council (MECs), Executive Mayors, Director-General of Limpopo Provincial Government, Heads of Departments, Heads of State-Owned Entities and their board chairpersons.

The meeting will assess the implementation of the Musina-Makhado Special Economic Zone (SEZ); implementation of strategic infrastructure projects and give an update of the 2018 National Senior Certificate Examinations. Government will also present the twenty-five years review report and state of municipalities in the province.

- 2018/19 Conditional Grant and Equitable Share Rollovers

- 2018/19 Proposed Provincial Adjustment Allocations
- 2019/20 Provincial Fiscal Framework
- Infrastructure Budget Allocations for the 2019/20 MTEF

Premier's Employment Growth Advisory Council

Premier Mathabatha will at the same venue meet with members of the Premier's Employment Growth Advisory Council (PEGAC) on the 15 November 2018. PEGAC meetings are held twice in the financial year in line with the planning cycle of government.

Members of PEGAC are appointed for a term of five years to advise the Premier on the implementations of Limpopo Development Plan. The team consists of members from the private sector, civil society and academia. PEGAC has six Technical Working Groups (TWGs) that are co-chaired by chairpersons of EXCO Clusters and a member from PEGAC.

The meeting is a platform for PEGAC members to report to the Premier on progress made in the implementation of recommendations taken during various Technical Working Groups meetings (TWGs).
