Premier Mathabatha to handover boreholes in Malebitsa Village

The Premier of Limpopo, Mr Chupu Stanley Mathabatha will hand-over three boreholes to the community of Malebitsa Village, tomorrow on the 07 May 2019 at 09h00.

The village had three debilitated boreholes. The Premier then requested Lepelle Northern Water to conduct an assessment on the three dysfunctional boreholes subsequently, submitting a report to the Premier's Office. The three identified boreholes were refurbished in Malebitsa and they will benefit more than 450 households in Section A & B.

Malebitsa Village is in ward 1 of Ephraim Mogale Local Municipality, Sekhukhune District. Water remains a scare commodity in the Province and the country at large. This boreholes will go a long way in alleviating this challenge. The Premier will be joined by the Executive Mayor of Sekhukhune District Municipality, Cllr Stan Ramaila and Lepelle Northern Water CEO PK Legodi.
