INTER MINISTERIAL COMMITTEE DECISIONS ON VUWANI

The Inter Ministerial Committee on Vuwani met on Wednesday and looked into several issues with regard to the Vuwani communities. The Committee has therefore noted the Demarcation Board decision not to review the Vuwani boundaries as requested by the Senior Traditional Leaders and Stakeholders in Vuwani.

The Inter Ministerial Committee has also noted the response as captured in a statement issued by Khosi Masia, on behalf of all affected Mahosi or Traditional Leaders within the area. We however wish to register our displeasure as the Inter Ministerial Committee that Senior Traditional Leaders have decided to communicate with us through the media.

The Inter Ministerial Committee reiterates its stance of a transparent and robust continuous engagement with affected communities. These engagements are premised in the belief that our people have the right to access water, electricity, roads and all services as mandated within the Constitution of the country. We also call for calm and leadership in the area.
