Limpopo Premier Chupu Mathabatha says the ruling against our daughter Caster Semenya by the Court of Arbitration for Sports (CSA) is a blow to the entire sporting world, and women in general.

The CSA made of three judges ruled against Caster Semenya's IAAF appeal that her testostrone levels are higher than average women and therefore should be reduced.

'together with all South African people Limpopo as the home of Caster feels the judgement and decision is unfair and borders on discrimination and has nothing to do with medical or psychological strengths of any kind', says Mathabatha.

Caster Semenya, born Mogadi near Polokwane in Limpopo has been participating in athletics all her life. Her sin is winning all the races she has ever participated in, beating her rivals from local to the International community.
