#### **Koko Malatji to receive a house from the government**

The Premier of Limpopo, Chupu Stanley Mathabatha continues to restore the dignity of Limpopo citizens. He is not happy with the fact that senior citizens stay in dilapidated houses. This month, he will hand over a house to Koko Makgomo Malatji on the 11<sup>th</sup> November 2016. A 102 year old senior citizen suffered hardship during her younger age as a farm worker. She stays in a two roomed house with her three grandchildren in Ga-Makhushane village, Andries section under Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality.

The Premier and his Executive Council will then proceed to the EXCO Imbizo to interact with the residents of Makhushane and surroundings. The EXCO will be held at Makhushane Moshate in Makhushane Village under Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality.

EXCO Imbizo is an interactive programme between government leaders and communities. The aim of the outreach programme is for government leadership to access first-hand information. This is also a platform for communities to raise issues concerning service delivery and let government intervene.

The Premier will also be accompanied by Executive Mayor of Mopani District Cllr Nkakareng Rakgoale, Mayor of Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality Cllr Pule Shayi, traditional leaders, Acting Director-General of our province and senior government officials.
