Limpopo Provincial Government to host National Anti-Corruption Strategy Stakeholder Engagement Forum – 28 August 2018

Limpopo Provincial Government will host the National Anti-Corruption Strategy Stakeholder Engagement Forum on 28 August 2018 at new Peter Mokaba Stadium, Polokwane.

The first ever anti-corruption strategy in South Africa was adopted in 2002. The Public Service Anti-corruption Strategy is focused on corruption within the public sector. The National Anti-Corruption Forum was formed to coordinate and have a mechanism of peer monitoring in and among the public sector (government), business and civil society.

After the 2009 general elections, government appointed the Anti-corruption Inter-Ministerial Committee (ACIMC) to drive the anti-corruption programme at the level of cabinet. The ACIMC appointed the Anti-corruption Task Team (ACTT) comprising of government agencies with anti-corruption mandate. The ACTT developed a national anti-corruption strategy which focuses on corruption both in government and in society.

Some of the objectives of this engagement are to obtain additional inputs on the strategic pillars of the proposed national anti-corruption strategy, to create awareness amongst key stakeholders in provinces to ensure a fully inclusive consultation process

and to inform stakeholders about the process of developing the national anti-corruption strategy
