These issues contained in the research report are receiving attention from the relevant government departments. During the Imbizo, the communities will voice suggestions on how to resolve these challenges and others encountered on daily bases. The Provincial Government has rolled out the Community Works Programme (CWP), providing community members of Rietfontein with job based training. This programme and others offered by various government entities will go a long way towards poverty alleviation in the area.
