Limpopo Premier to handover Phasha/Mampuru road

Limpopo Premier Mr Stanley Chupu Mathabatha will officially handover Phasha/Mampuru road. This is a 23.7 km road which was tarred just before Mampuru village and passes through the villages of Ga-Phasha, Ga-Mapodile and Tukakgomo to join the existing D1296 outside Steelpoort.

Road Agency Limpopo built this road over a period of 36 months from July 2015 to August 2018 at a cost of over R354 million. The road has created some benefit to the communities in terms of job creation to SMMEs, access to social amenities, and socio-economic. The MEC for Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure Mme Nandi Ndalane, CEO of Road Agency Limpopo Mr Maselaganye Matji will join the Premier.
