Mr Ramphele Lesetja Johannes previously stayed in a single corrugated iron shack that he built himself. Through the Department of CoGHSTA, Mr Ramphele has been allocated a house. The Provincial Government continues to restore dignity of destitute families to ensure that they too can enjoy the benefits of our democracy and live a better life.

The Premier and his Executive Council will proceed to Mamadimo sport ground to engage communities at an EXCO outreach programme. EXCO Outreach programmes were put to hold due to the local government elections. The outreach will be held in at Moletjie Ga Ramphele under Polokwane Municipality.
