Limpopo Government commend law enforcement officers during ZCC year end pilgrimage

Limpopo Provincial Government commend SAPS, EMS and Traffic officers deployed over the weekend during the Zion Christian Church (ZCC) year-end worship gathering at Zion City Moria.

The officers were deployed on N1 Bridge, R71, R81, R37, N11 and D19 to ensure that road users obey the rules and regulations. As Provincial Government, we recognise and thank them for their efforts to ensure road incidents are reduced and there is zero tolerance to those breaking the law.
