Limpopo Premier Chupu Mathabatha is hosting engineers, doctors, professors, intellectuals and politicians in what is called Premier Economic Growth Advisory Council, PEGAC.

This collective is meeting at Bela Bela, to among others, report on progress made by the working groups since their last meeting held before Covid-19.

The 50 member group of professional mix, is tasked with advising the Premier and his members of the Executive Council on issues ranging from:

1. Infrastructure and Economic Growth;
2. Social Unity and Cohesion;
3. Mining, Agriculture and Tourism, to name but a few.
