The government has recognised the importance of sustainable climate resilient economies and communities in Vision 2030 which requires that we sustain South Africa's ecosystems and use natural resources efficiently.

In this regard, the NDP states that the country needs to implement measures to protect South Africa's natural resources including an environmental management framework in which developments that have serious environmental or social effects need to be offset by support for improvements in related areas and a target for the amount of land and oceans under protection.
