Premier Mathabatha to visit road accident patients and water stricken Giyani residents

The Premier of Limpopo, Mr Chupu Stanley Mathabatha will visit affected roads accident patients and provide support to families to identify the bodies at Mokopane Hospital today on the 21 October 2018 at 11h00 am. The Premier will be accompanied by MEC for Transport and Community Safety Makoma Makurupetje and Health MEC Dr Phophi Ramathuba when the families identifies the bodies.

Premier Mathabatha and MECs will also wish the survivors speedy recovery. The accident happened during a period that is declared Transport month and the Provincial Government is preparing to host Transport Indaba.

The Premier will then proceed to meet the leadership in Mopani District Municipality to map way forward on the issues affecting provision of clean portable water as basic service to our communities at 13h00.

This meeting is about resolving the water shortage resulting from the alleged non payment of service provider by Department of Water and Sanitation.

He will be accompanied by MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development Mr Basikop Makamu, Executive Mayor of Mopani Cllr Nkakareng Rakgoale, Mayor of Greater Giyani Local Municipality Cllr Sasavona Mathebula and officials from Lepelle Northern Water. The Premier will then lead the entourage to handover water project at Makhosa village.
