FAKE PREMIER WARNING IN LIMPOPO

The Office of the Premier in Limpopo is warning South African citizens anywhere in the world and especially friends and colleagues and government of an impersonator who calls himself Limpopo Premier Chupu Stan Mathabatha.

The modus of the impersonator is to call the potential victim and request for urgent cash which should be deposited into Shoprite or any quick cash shop. Earlier operandis included a business deal and a plan to get lucrative tenders.

The Office is warning anyone who might receive such request to immediately report to the nearest law enforcement agency or the South African Police Services (SAPS).

Limpopo Premier has never, and will not call any of his colleagues either in the NEC, Cabinet, PEC or anywhere else for monetary assistance or tendering. Such activities are foreign to him.
