The MEC responsible for the Department of Social Development, Ms Nandi Ndalane will this afternoon (17 November 2022) visit Sethe family to pay homage following the horrific accident wich claimed nine family members.

After the unforunate accident which happened on Saturday 11 November 2022, MEC Ndalane instructed the Departmental Social workers to visit Sethe family in order to provide containment and trauma management to the family. The Departmental social workers following their visit, have identified that the family will require therapeutic counselling, family preservation as well as grieving councelling. Since the incident, social workers have been vising the family to provide counselling in line with the assessment.

"it is in times like this where grieving families need our support and all material resources they require in order to be able to deal with the tragedy. We will continue to provide counselling to the family and support in line with our Departmental mandate," said Ndalane.
