Re: Myriad activities in Limpopo for Mandela Day

The Limpopo Provincial Government will have myriad activities to mark Mandela Day on 18 July 2023. Members of the Executive Council will be in various districts to honour and observe the day.

The Acting Premier Mr Seaparo Sekoati will be with the Minister of Health, Dr Joe Phaahla, at the Sod Turning Ceremony of the Provincial Central Academic Hospital in Polokwane on Webster Street.

The MEC responsible for Social Development, Ms Nandi Ndalane, will spend the day at Thabang Child and Youth Care Centre in Thabazimbi. This facility accommodates and cares for abandoned children of aged between 5 and 19 years old. MEC Ndalane together with Senior Management of the Department will cook and eat lunch with the children. Other activities include planting of trees as well as vegetables at the facility. The MEC will further donate blankets as well as sanitary towels.

The Limpopo Department Of Education MEC Ms Mavhungu Lerule-Ramakhanya will be in Phalaborwa with the Minister of Higher Education, Science and Technology.

The Minister of Higher Education, Science and Innovation, Dr BE Nzimande will attend the Mandela Day Celebration events in Limpopo wherein he will handover a house built by Mopani TVET College apprentices and address a career exhibition at Maphokwane High School, Mashishimale village located in the Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality.

The MEC for Transport and Community Safety, Ms Florence Radzilani will visit Epilepsy Elandsdoorn Centre in Moutse, Elias Motsoaledi Municipality where she will hand over blankets, plant trees and spend time with the patients in that area.

Cooperative Governance Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs MEC,Mr Basikopo Makamu, will be handing over computers to Calais High School at Baloon outside Sekororo, Tzaneen Municipality. He will also paint the walls of some classes and clean the yard of that school.

Limpopo Provincial Treasury will be at Mafefe, Lepelle-Nkumpi Municipality Nokotlou High School on 21 July 2023. They will paint, replace ceiling boards, plant fruit trees and vegetables.

The district and local municipalities will also have activities in their areas, others running until the end of the month of July
