UPDATE ON HIGHLY PATHOGENIC AVIAN INFLUENZA OUTBREAK IN LIMPOPO

The Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (LDARD) would like to update people of Limpopo on the outbreak of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI). To date a total of five (5) HPAI outbreaks were confirmed in commercial chicken farms in the Waterberg District Municipality. Three in Bela Bela Local Municipality, one (1) in Modimolle-Mokgoopong Local Municipality and one (1) in Mogalakwena Local Municipality.

All affected farms have been immediately placed under quarantine and no live animals/birds and eggs are allowed to be removed from the farm. LDARD would like to reassure consumers that commercial poultry meat and eggs are safe to eat. Birds affected with HPAI get sick quickly and die. Generally, the first sign of sick animals and birds is the drop in production, meaning birds will produce very few (if any) eggs.

The quarantine of infected farms means that no eggs or chicken from infected farms, will make its way to the shelves. We strongly encourage all poultry farmers including those with birds kept for as a hobby to adhere to strict biosecurity measures to prevent the introduction of HPAI. LDARD also urge farmers and individuals to report any suspect outbreak to their nearest agricultural office, Animal Health Technician, State Veterinarian or Private Veterinarian.
