PUBLIC WORKS, ROADS AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEPARTMENT AND THE PALABORA MINING COMPANY TO CONDUCT A SOD-TURNING CEREMONY FOR THE UPGRADING AND REHABILITATION OF ROADS IN PHALABORWA.

The Limpopo MEC for Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure, Nkakareng Rakgoale, will spearhead a sod-turning ceremony for the upgrading of D3786 Mashishimale Road, while at the same time committing to rehabilitate some portion of the same road, from Maseke-Mashishimale. The rehabilitation of roads will also include road D4424 Matikoxikaya-Lulekani in the Ba-Phalaborwa Municipal area.

The sod-turning ceremony will mark the start of the R205 million road projects that have been jointly funded by the department's entity Roads Agency Limpopo and Palabora Mining Company. These access roads link several residential areas with the busy R71-road which leads to the Tourism and Mining town of Phalaborwa in the Mopani District. This collaboration will go a long way in ensuring that the condition of the roads infrastructure in the area is improved immensely. The event has been scheduled as follows:
