MEC RADZILANI SADDENED BY AN ACCIDENT THAT CLAIMED THE LIVES OF LIMPOPO ELDERLY CITIZENS, IN MPUMALANGA.

Limpopo MEC for Transport and Community Safety, Florence Radzilani, has learned with sadness, about the deaths of 7 elderly members, who are congregants of the Lutheran Church in Mogalakwena, who died in a road accident, on the R 37 towards Lydenburg in the Mpumalanga Province, on Saturday, 09 December 2023.

According to reports, the deceased were a part of a group of 'golden boys and girls', who were travelling to Mpumalanga for a Church activity, when their bus overturned, due to a tyre puncture.

The MEC learned of this accident yesterday in the evening, and has sent messages of condolences to the families of the victims, and also wished a speedy recovery to the survivors.

The MEC has has expressed her sadness over this incident, which claimed the lives of elderly citizens who were travelling to a place of worship.
