The Limpopo Provincial Government in partnership with the University of Limpopo (UL) and University of Venda (UNIVEN) will commemorate Africa Day on 24 May 2024 at the University of Limpopo.

The commemoration will be held under the theme "Celebrating 30 Years of Freedom: Building a Better Africa and a Better World".
