MEC MATHYE TO LAUNCH THE LIMPOPO OCTOBER TRANSPORT MONTH PROGRAMME

Limpopo MEC for Transport and Community Safety, Violet Mathye will launch the Provincial 2024 October Transport Month (OTM) Programme through a community engagement session in Mookgophong, Waterberg District.

The 2024 OTM programme marks its 19th annual installment, showcasing achievements in transport services and infrastructure. Conceived by the Transport Lekgotla in 2005, its initial objective was to address traffic congestion by promoting public transport use. The campaign has now evolved to assess the strength of transport policies and programmes to address the urgent needs of South Africans.

This year's theme is "Doing more together: Building better transport infrastructure and services through collaboration."

Mookgophong was selected for engagement due to high pedestrian fatalities on the N1 freeway. The MEC's engagement aims to promote pedestrian safety, responsible road use, and law enforcement efforts in the area.
