PREMIER DR PHOPHI RAMATHUBA TO VISIT RAPE SURVIVORS AT TLHARIHANI TVET CAMPUS IN MOPANI DISTRICT

Limpopo Premier, Dr Phophi Ramathuba will visit four students who were recently subjected to a horrific attack at Tlharihani TVET Campus in Mamaila, Mopani District. The Premier will be accompanied by the MEC for Transport and Community Safety, Ms Violet Mathye.

According to police reports, a suspect allegedly broke into the students' residence, attacked and raped four students before fleeing the scene with their valuables on 22 February 2025. An extensive manhunt for the suspect, following the registration of a case involving four counts of rape and armed robbery, has since been launched.

Premier Dr Ramathuba has strongly condemned this heinous act and emphasised the urgent need to enhance student safety.

"We urge law enforcement agencies to leave no stone unturned in ensuring that this perpetrator is apprehended and faces the full might of the law. Our students deserve to feel safe in their learning environments. As a province, we must work collectively to create a society where no one lives in fear," said Premier Dr Ramathuba.
