## LIMPOPO GOVERNMENT TO CELEBRATE HERITAGE DAY 2025 IN ROYAL KINGDOM TJATE III, SEKHUKHUNE.

The Limpopo Provincial Government will join the rest of South Africa in celebrating Heritage Day on 24 September 2025 in Royal Kingdom Tjate III, Mohlaletse, Fetakgomo-Tubatse Municipality in Sekhukhune.

The celebrations will be held under the theme: “Reimagine our Heritage Institutions for a New Era.” The theme emphasises the importance of leveraging heritage as a foundation for building a dynamic, socially responsive, technologically innovative and economically inclusive future.
