### LIMPOPO MEC FOR PUBLIC WORKS, ROADS AND INFRASTRUCTURE ERNEST RACHOENE LAUNCHES #PROJECTMONITORING PROGRAMME

The Limpopo MEC for Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure, Ernest Rachoene, has officially launched #ProjectMonitoring — a hands-on programme designed to enable the MEC to visit all construction projects across the province, assess progress, and resolve challenges that may hinder implementation.

Today marked the inaugural leg of the programme, during which MEC Rachoene visited the Department's Waterberg District Offices in Modimolle, currently undergoing refurbishment. He also inspected the Mokhari Secondary School project in Mookgophong, which has experienced periodic work stoppages due to tensions between the contractor and certain community structures.

MEC Rachoene emphasized the importance of this initiative, highlighting its role in accelerating project delivery and strengthening accountability.

"This is a very important programme as it allows me to gain first-hand experience of the work being done by the Department, particularly on behalf of our client departments. We had a very productive visit in the Waterberg District and we appreciate the quality of work being carried out by our Department as the provincial landlord. In many ways, this initiative extends our #StakeholdersTuesdays engagements by allowing us to interact directly with the beneficiaries of these service delivery projects," he said.

The MEC further commended progress at the Mokopane Government Complex, which is being revitalized to accommodate four government departments upon completion.

His visit concluded at the LEDET Suid Street Building, also under refurbishment.

"We want to see all projects completed within the stipulated timelines and budgets. Our goal is for client departments to be fully satisfied with the quality of our work, which ultimately contributes to improved service delivery by the Provincial Government," Rachoene added.

The MEC reiterated that all ongoing infrastructure projects across the province will be closely monitored under the #ProjectMonitoring programme to ensure improved delivery and value for money.
