## LIMPOPO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH WELCOMES THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE INTERDICT BROUGHT AGAINST SECURITY SERVICES CONTRACT

The Limpopo Department of Health notes and welcomes the decision to withdraw an urgent application to interdict the department from implementing the security service contract. The application was brought before the high court by one of the unseccusful applicant of the contract.

The Court's decision affirms the department's resolve to implement the new security contract as planned, with commencement scheduled for 1 March 2026.

The Department wishes to reiterate that the procurement process was conducted in accordance with applicable legislative and regulatory prescripts governing public sector supply chain management. At all times, the Department has remained committed to principles of fairness, transparency, competitiveness and cost-effectiveness.

Security services play a critical role in safeguarding patients, staff, infrastructure and public assets across our health facilities. The timely implementation of the new contract will ensure continuity and stability of these essential services.

The Department respects the right of any party to seek legal recourse. We remain focused on our core mandate of delivering quality healthcare services to the people of Limpopo and will continue to act in the best interests of the public we serve.
