## LIMPOPO PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT LAUNCHES SERVICE DELIVERY WEEK IN GIYANI LOCAL MUNICIPALITY

The Limpopo Provincial Government has designated the period 07 to 10 April 2026 as “Service Delivery Week” in jurisdiction of Giyani Local Municipality, as part of a coordinated provincial effort to bring services closer to communities and to respond decisively to service delivery challenges.

This focused intervention, directed by the Premier of Limpopo, Dr Phophi Ramathuba, is aimed at strengthening government responsiveness, accelerating service delivery at local level and ensuring that communities in and around Giyani benefit directly from the presence of government departments on the ground.

The Service Delivery Week comes at a time when parts of Giyani have been affected by flooding, which has caused damage to infrastructure and disrupted access to basic services. As such, departments will not only deliver services but will also conduct follow-up interventions, damage assessments and provide support to affected households and communities.

Premier Ramathuba said the province remains committed to practical, visible and integrated service delivery. “Our people deserve a government that is present, responsive and focused on action. Through Service Delivery Week in Giyani, we are bringing departments together to work as one government, to support communities, restore services and address the effects of flooding while also accelerating development,” said Premier Dr Ramathuba.

During the week, various departments will be implementing programmes across Giyani and surrounding areas, including but not limited to: distribution of agricultural production inputs to farmers affected by disaster; opening of refurbished health facilities, including EMS and mortuary services; site visits to Temporary Residential Units; distribution of school shoes, books, laptops, beds, sewing machines and other learning support materials; support to schools with equipment and the sod-turning of the new Makhuvha Library; awareness campaigns on teenage pregnancy, gender-based violence and elderly abuse; road maintenance, pothole patching, bush clearing and upgrading of key roads; liquor education, business registration awareness, consumer rights education and responsible gambling awareness; distribution of food parcels and blankets to vulnerable households.

The Limpopo Provincial Government encourages communities to participate in the scheduled activities and welcomes the opportunity to engage directly with government on service delivery priorities.
