MEC RACHOENE ON PROJECT MONITORING DRIVE IN CAPRICORN DISTRICT

Limpopo MEC for Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure, Ernest Rachoene, today embarked on a project monitoring drive in the Capricorn District, just a day after delivering the Department's 2026/27 Budget Speech, where he outlined progress and plans relating to key infrastructure projects across the province.

His first stop was at Road D3614 in Madishaditoro, under the Lepelle-Nkumpi Local Municipality, where a five-kilometre stretch is currently being upgraded as part of the Department's 21 new road projects.

The project is presently at 40% completion.

The Department is also implementing 22 road rehabilitation projects across the province. As part of the monitoring visit, MEC Rachoene inspected rehabilitation work underway on Road D844 in Sebayeng, under the Polokwane Local Municipality.

The two projects inspected today are currently at 40% and 70% completion respectively.

MEC Rachoene welcomed the cooperation between all stakeholders involved in the implementation of the projects.

"What gives us comfort that these projects will be completed soon is the strong working relationship between councillors, traditional leadership, communities and contractors," said MEC Rachoene.

The Department remains committed to implementing infrastructure projects that ensure the provincial road network remains safe, accessible and drivable for all road users.
