

## MEDIA ACCREDITATION CALL FOR THE ENGAGEMENT BETWEEN GOVERNMENT AND TRADITIONAL LEADERSHIP IN LIMPOPO PROVINCE

Deputy President Shipokosa Paulus Mashatile will, on Friday, 12 June 2026, undertake a visit to Limpopo Province to engage with Traditional Leaders in Polokwane, Capricorn District.

The engagement forms part of Government's ongoing commitment to strengthen the institution of Traditional Leadership and fostering collaboration between Government and traditional communities.

Discussions will focus, among others, on Government support to Traditional institutions, social challenges confronting communities, the interface between Traditional Leadership and Local and Provincial Government, local economic development and employment opportunities, as well as progress made in accelerating the land reform programme.

Deputy President Mashatile chairs the Inter-Ministerial Task Team on Traditional Leadership, established by President Cyril Ramaphosa to address matters raised by Traditional and Khoi-San Leaders and to strengthen cooperation between Government and Traditional institutions.
