LIMPOPO PREMIER DR RAMATHUBA TO OFFICIALLY HAND OVER A HOUSE TO FAMILY OF CONJOINED TWINS IN PHALABORWA

Limpopo Premier, Dr Phophi Ramathuba, will officially hand over a newly constructed house to the family of conjoined twins in Lulekani, under Ba-Phalaborwa Local Municipality in the Mopani District, on Wednesday, 08 July 2026.

The conjoined twins were born on 28 January 2026 at Mankweng Tertiary Hospital, on the outskirts of Polokwane. During a visit to the mother of the twins in hospital, the Premier committed to building a formal dwelling for the family. This commitment followed a social worker's report on the household profile, which indicated that the mother, her other children, her mother and other family members were living without formal housing. The Premier's pledge was made to ensure that the family lives in a dignified and safe structure and environment.

The handing over of the house forms part of Service Delivery Week in Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality, Mopani District, which is aimed at improving service provision in the area as part of the District Development Model (DDM). The programme commenced on Monday, 06 July 2026.

Monitoring of services began with surprise visits by Premier Dr Ramathuba to the Home Affairs offices in Phalaborwa Town, SASSA offices, and Maphutha Malatji Hospital in Namakgale.

Other Members of the Executive Council (MECs) have been deployed to different government departments to assess service delivery and monitor government projects in the area. Various critical infrastructure projects, including those in water, sanitation, agriculture and roads, will also be visited to assess progress and ensure completion as scheduled.

The Service Delivery Week will culminate in a meeting with selected stakeholders on Friday, 10 July 2026, at Mopani TVET College in Phalaborwa Town.
